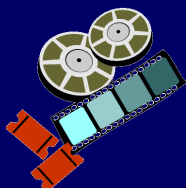

### IMPORTANT: RECALL INFORMATION

Frito-Lay has announced that they are recalling Jalapeño Flavored Miss Vickie's Kettle Cooked potato chips due to the potential presence of Salmonella in the seasoning. This action is the direct result of a supplier's recent recall of a seasoning blend which includes jalapeño powder that could contain Salmonella. Please know that no Salmonella was found in the seasoning supplied to Frito-Lay. They have decided to recall the product out of an abundance of caution.

If you have in your possession any of these sealed products that were purchased from January 1, 2017, to present, please return them to your commissary distribution site by May 12th, 2017 with sales receipt attached for a full refund.

### Education Minute

*This week's topic: GED Classes and Schedules*

As you may already know, Oregon requires all incarcerated individuals to have a GED or High School Diploma. If you do not have one, you are automatically entered on an Education waiting list and will be scheduled for orientation and any required pretesting as soon as possible after arrival at SRCI.

GED classes are scheduled all day and evening in all three complexes, and we work to place you in the best class time considering space availability and your current schedule. If you are in GED, ABE, or ESL and you would like to change assigned class times, you just need to send an Inmate Communication to Education Box B334.

All class moves are done during quarterly breaks, but they are first-come, first served so get your request in before the break starts to be considered for a move!

The Correctional Rehabilitation Services section is hosting a May Luncheon.

The inmate's sack lunch will be provided.

Each sack lunch will include the following: 2 sandwiches, chips, cookies, and raw veggies. Drinks will also be provided.

- Please send an approved CD28 for the total amount (\$2.00 for each person in your visiting party that needs a sack lunch) with account #2637 communication to Mr. Vokral at box #B343. Please insure all CD28's are legible.
- Visitors must be on your current approved list, the complete names of the visitors attending must be listed on an attached to communication form to M. Vokral.
- Please do not sign up if you are on LOP, incentive level 1, or on basic visiting status.
- Refunds will not be given to those inmates that are unable to attend due to their own actions or if visitors do not attend.
- Make sure your signature is verified on your CD28 by a Correctional Officer.
- Adults in custody who have not attended the previous lunch will be given priority to attend this upcoming lunch.
- Communications with CD28's must be received no later than May 4th 2017.
- The first 55 inmates that meet the above criteria will be able to attend this event.
- Inmates that have NOT attended prior luncheons and meet the above criteria will be offered a higher priority in attending this event.
- Visitors are encouraged to arrive prior to 10:30 am to attend luncheon to allow adequate time to be processed into the event. Although the Department of Corrections understands that circumstances occasionally arise that may hinder your families' arrival. Please advise them if they are going to be delayed past the 10:30 am time they should contact the Institution. This will assist the Officer in Charge to make other arrangements if necessary to make their visit enjoyable.

## Story Link Book Reading for Family

Story Link will allow qualifying Adults in Custody to read to an immediate family member (child or grandchild). Volunteers will bring an assortment of books to choose from and then record Adults in Custody reading a story which is burned to a CD. The Book and CD will be sent to the family. – NO COST to the inmate.

### Dates:

- Complex 1, April 25, 2017
- Complex 2, May 30, 2017
- Complex 3, June 27, 2017

### Qualifications:

- An inmate with a No Contact Order (NCO) is strictly prohibited from sending the book and recording to anyone within the NCO.
- The proposed recipient must be between the ages of 2 and 14.
- The proposed recipient must be on the inmate's approved visiting list.
- The proposed recipient must be the inmate's child, grandchild, step-child, or step-grandchild.
- The inmate must be incentive level 2 or 3.
- There are no exceptions to these qualifications.

### Procedures:

- Choose one book to read and send to your family. If you have more than one child, you may select a book that all will enjoy. Only one book and recording may be sent.
- Readings will be limited to six (6) minutes. You will also be able to record a one (1) minute message to your child/grandchild. If you choose a chapter book, you will still be limited to this time frame.
- DO NOT send Inmate Communication Forms asking for specific books. The books are donated and book boxes are divided into the following ages: 2-4, 5-6, 7-10, and 11-14. You will be able to select a book from those provided.
- When you come to read your book you will need to bring the name and address of the person you are sending the recording to – this is VERY important.

### To Sign Up:

Send an application from the housing unit to Mr. M. Galemore, Box B343, letting him know that you would like to participate. The application form MUST include: name of the child you will be reading to AND the name of the parents/guardian that will be receiving the recording. Applications are being accepted. ## Hepatitis Awareness Month

May is Hepatitis Awareness Month

"Hepatitis" means inflammation of the liver and is usually caused by a virus. In the U.S., the most common types are Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, and Hepatitis C. Millions of Americans are living with viral hepatitis but most do not know they are infected. People can live with chronic hepatitis for decades without having symptoms.

Testing for Hepatitis in ODOC is FREE. - kyte Ms. Galemore box 232  
Vaccine for Hepatitis A and B in ODOC is FREE.

## Two-Year Renewals

Inmate Services Unit (ISU) technicians are completing a visitor clean-up project by completing background reviews on all visitors 15 years and older that have been on your visiting list for two years or longer. Additionally, per Oregon Administrative Rule 291-127-0285 on Visiting (Inmate), any visitor that hasn't visited in the previous **two years** will be removed from the inmate's list unless ISU is notified otherwise.

We ask that you consider **waiting until your visitor is ready to visit** before adding them back to your list. Our visiting application process is very streamlined, so we can complete most applications within a week of receipt unless there is some background issue. This will also help keep your visiting list updated and accurate, and ensure new applications continue to be processed as quickly as possible.

What this means:

1. On May 15, 2017, any visitor that has not visited in the past two years will be automatically removed from your visiting list.
2. You will receive notifications of visitors that are removed. Again, we recommend you reapply when your visitor is ready to visit.
3. ISU Technicians will focus on completing background checks on all visitors on your visiting list for two years or longer, who are still visiting.
4. You will be notified if a visitor is found to no longer be eligible to visit.
5. The Inmate Services Unit knows how important it is for you to connect with your family and friends, mentors, and support. We want to help make this clean-up project as smooth as possible, so please share this information with your visitors.
