Standard Single Vision Plastic Lenses with frame: \$45.00
Standard Lined Bifocal Plastic Lenses with frame: \$50.00
Standard Lined Trifocal Plastic Lenses with frame: \$55.00
Note: All standard lenses come in plastic with a scratch-resistant coating.

Polycarbonate Lenses and Frame Packages

Single Vision Polycarbonate lenses with frame: \$60.00
Lined Bifocal Polycarbonate lenses with frame: \$65.00
Lined Trifocal Polycarbonate lenses with frame: \$70.00

Grey Transitional Lenses and Frame Packages

Transitional Single Vision Plastic lenses with frame: \$65.00
Transitional Lined Bifocal Plastic lenses with frame: \$80.00
Transitional Lined Trifocal Plastic lenses with frame: \$95.00

Transitional Single Vision Polycarbonate lenses with frame: \$75.00
Transitional Lined Bifocal Polycarbonate lenses with frame: \$90.00
Transitional Lined Trifocal Polycarbonate lenses with frame: \$105.00

Visitors must be on your current approved list.

Please do not sign up if you are on basic visiting status.

Make sure your signature is verified on your CD28 by a Correctional Officer.

You must provide a minimum of (2) two week notice for the date of the visit.

DOC Policy "Prison Rape Elimination Act" (Tab #40.1.13)

In 2003 the federal government enacted the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA). In May 2012, the US Department of Justice released its final rule in accordance with PREA. The purpose of this law is to reduce the number of sexual abuse and sexual harassments in confinement settings by focusing on prevention, detection and response.

The Oregon Department of Corrections fully supports the guidelines set forth in this law and remains committed to a zero-tolerance policy for sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Sexual abuse or harassment from other inmates or staff is never okay, and never your fault.

There are some key things you can do to protect yourself from being a victim.

- Avoid isolated or secluded areas.
- Be aware of your body language.
- Never share personal information.
- Never borrow canteen items.
- Never accept gifts from another inmate.
- Be cautious of inmates offering to protect you.
- Report all acts of violence against you.

If you are the victim of a sexual abuse or sexual harassment your best defense is to report the incident as quickly as possible. There are multiple ways to report sexual abuse, sexual harassment, retaliation for reporting and staff neglect or violation of responsibilities that may have contributed to such incidents. You may report:

- In person to any staff.
- Through an inmate communication.
- Through the grievance system.
- Call the Inspector General's Hotline (Pick up handset and dial "9").
- Write the Governor's Office (State Capitol, Room 160, 900 Court St., Salem, Oregon 97301) You may request to remain anonymous.
- Friends or family can report on your behalf (877- 678-4222).

By reporting, you will receive treatment to deal with the consequences of being victimized and you will prevent the perpetrator from victimizing others. You can be assured that the information will be received in a confidential manner.

If you have been victimized, it is important to remember not to wash away the evidence.

- Don't shower.
- Don't remove or wash your clothes.
- Don't brush your teeth.

You may also seek advocacy by simply dialing your PIN on the inmate telephone system followed by "711." Calls to this number are free of charge. When leaving a message, please leave your name, SID # and a brief description of what you would like to speak about with the DOC PREA Advocate. The DOC PREA Advocate will schedule a return call to you through institution staff within two to three business days. Please note: The DOC PREA Advocate is an employee and is required to report allegations of sexual abuse. This number does not replace the current DOC PREA reporting hotline that is available by dialing 9 on the inmate telephone system.
