You must have attended graduation this year to have a tassel mailed home. If you are a BCT graduate, your tassel will be included with your portfolio and sent out upon release unless your family took it home after graduation.

We hope to have photos ready to go before Thanksgiving. You will be called out to C2 Education to pick them up when they are ready.

## Holiday Debt Collection Suspension

- The 2016 holiday buying period runs Monday, November 28, 2016 through Friday, December 30, 2016.
- Spending limits will be doubled during the holiday buying period.
- **If you are INDEBTED read this:** Debt will be collected through November 23, 2016, prior to the beginning of the holiday buying period. DOC is exercising the discretion of the Assistant Director of Operations, according to Trust rule 291-158-0065 to designate November 23, 2016 as the last business day of the month, prior to the holiday buying period.
- During the holiday buying period, Central Trust will not collect existing DOC debt. However, non-DOC debt, such as court fees and garnishment orders, will be collected during the buying period, as well as fine associated with new disciplinary sanctions that are applied to your trust account.
- During the holiday buying period, inmates who are indebted to DOC may only spend funds posted to their account for postage, copies, institution club activities, and commissary items.
- If you are indebted, Central Trust will not process CD-28s to send funds out.
- At the conclusion of the holiday buying period, any funds remaining in account of indebted inmates will be collected and applied to their debt.

## Inmate Clothing Faded Stenciling

All inmate clothing with no stenciling or faded stenciling must be turned into the Inmate Clothing Room, particularly pants. Send inmate clothing items, along with a Clothing Request Form, to the Inmate Clothing Room to have them stenciled or replaced. Inmate Clothing items found by staff with faded or no stenciling will be confiscated by staff.

## Lifting of Restrictions



Loss of Privileges will be lifted as follows for the **Veterans Day Holiday** starting at 8:00 am on Friday, November 11, 2016 and ending at 10:00 pm on Sunday, November 13, 2016.

- Level 1 no lifting of holiday LOP
- Level 2 & 3 lifting of LOP on actual holiday only

Privileges restricted by an Inmate Management Plan issued by the Security Threat Management Unit are not lifted during Holiday periods. These restrictions remain in effect and are enforced until the date specified on the Inmate Management Plan.

This does not restrict normal operations and progressive discipline, such as cell-ins or transfer to segregation for poor behavior that may be seen as a threat to others and/or the safety and security of the institution.
