### **Evening Winter Activities**

Summer night yard activities will conclude on Sunday, October 1, 2017. The Evening winter activities will begin Monday, October 2, 2017. A line for the evening activities will be run from the eligible housing units to the Recreation Yard building after the evening meal. This will be the only line out. Evening yard ends at 9:00 p.m.

The following rules will be in effect:

Scheduling will be in three groups on a rotating basis.

- (1) A-Block, C-Block, Dorm
- (2) D-Block
- (3) E-Block

Blocks will be rotated every third night starting with (Blocks as listed as above) on October 2, 2017. Only the inmates living in the scheduled block(s) will be allowed to go.

The line from the eligible block(s) will go down the main avenue and enter the Recreation Yard through electric gate #9, at the southwest corner of the basketball court. All inmates will proceed directly across the basketball court to the door entering the Card Room. No inmate will be allowed to remain outside the Recreation Yard building. On the night their assigned block is scheduled for evening yard activities, evening workers will be allowed to go to the Recreation Yard building, directly after their shower. The Card Room, Basketball Court, Pool Room, and showers will be open.

Shorts are allowed to be worn to evening winter activities in the Recreation Yard building. They can only be worn directly to the yard during the line movement. Pants cannot be carried if the inmate is wearing shorts. A movie will be shown on the television system in the Card Room. No other programming will be allowed on this television system.

Sports programming will be shown on the sports television **except** on minority viewing nights. Minority viewing nights will be Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

An optional Cell Line, Pill Line, will be called at 8:00 p.m. There will be no returning to the yard from this line. Inmates are expected to be wearing pants while participating in Pill Line or standing on the Control Floor.

**Inmate Self-Medication Instructions**

**Inmate Orders**

(Violation will result in a misconduct report)

1. Do not break apart the blister pack.
2. Do not possess medication that has expired.
3. Do not possess another inmate's medication.
4. Do not give any of your medication to or, accept any medication from another inmate.

5. Do not possess a loose (unpackaged) pill(s) unless specifically approved by the Health Services Section.
6. You are responsible to lock your medication in your housing storage area.

**General Instructions**

1. Return your medication to the Health Services Section for the following unless specifically instructed otherwise:
  - a. The date on your prescription has expired.
  - b. The blister pack is empty.
  - c. The prescription or medication has been changed or discontinued by a prescribing practitioner.
2. A Health Services' employee may request you to bring your medication to the Health Services' Section periodically to be examined.
3. Medication refills may take five to seven working days to arrive. As such, you need to request a refill from the Health Services Section five to seven days before a refill is needed.
4. You will be given medication in a blister pack for a 30 day period of time or less.
5. If you are found in non-compliance of the self-medication system you will be required to report to the medication line for any further medication.
6. Some medications may require a modified self-medication process until you can demonstrate compliance with instructions. The Health Services' employee will determine how the self-medication process will be modified and when you can assume the full self-medication system.
