The OSP CAD Unit is recruiting to fill open positions for Production CAD Operators. Drafting or Solid Modeling experience using the following software is preferred: AutoCAD, Autodesk Inventor, Solidworks, Catia and Pro-E. Also knowledge of the following programs will be considered: AlphaCAM, Rhino, and Enroute. The production CAD unit supports the OCE Metal Fabrication and Furniture Factory Shops. The ability to work in a team atmosphere is required. The current schedule is Monday—Friday, 6:00 am to 2:00 pm. This position awards 14 PRAS points, with the opportunity to earn a matching Team Goal Award. Workers must be motivated and able to maintain a professional attitude at all times.

Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- Must have a valid social security number or equivalent
- Have at least 12 months (1 year) time incarcerated with clear conduct.
- Have no program failures in the past 6 months.
- Must have a release date after April 2018.
- Be able to work efficiently and professionally at all times.
- Note software experience with above referenced programs.
- Cannot be in any programs/activities which would conflict with the assigned shift.
- Be willing to sign an **eighteen (18) month retention agreement**—anyone leaving the assignment either by termination or resignation before serving the full retention period will be returned to the sending institution.

Those eligible for OSP honor housing will be placed on the honor housing waiting list upon arrival at OSP. Requirements for OSP honor housing are as follows:

- 5 years incarcerated
- 5 years clear conduct
- 3 years successful work assignment history
- 2 years no STM designator

All applicants will need to pass a DOC/OCE security screening and OCE interview before being considered for the position.
