### **40% EARNED TIME QUESTIONS**

The Legal Library has gotten many questions about the JULY 1<sup>st</sup> implementation of 40% earned time.

Staff has heard nothing.....

What is taking effect July 1<sup>st</sup> is 291.209-0030 OR Administrative Code (1) "All persons convicted of a felony and sentenced on or after August 1, 2013 to probation or to the legal & physical custody of the supervisory authority under ORS 137.124 (2) shall serve a minimum period of supervision before consideration for earned discharge under these rules Subsection 2 the maximum amount of time credits earned under this rule may not exceed 50% of the period of supervision imposed.

Subsection 3 time credits may not be used to shorten the period of supervision to less than 6 months." Statute Authority is ORS 137.633 effective July 25, 2013. (Available in Legal Library)

## Malcolm X Summer

### Reading Group

Malcolm X wrote in his autobiography: "I don't think anybody ever got more out of going to prison than I did." Despite having only an eighth-grade education, Malcolm became one of the most influential faces of social justice in the twentieth century. He credited this transformation in large part to his prison studies.

The Malcolm X Reading Group will meet twice a week over two weeks during late June and early July, exact dates to be determined, for a total of four sessions. Together, we will read the *Autobiography of Malcolm X* and explore other source material in order to build a foundation of motivation, positive transformation, and goal setting based on the life and legacy of Malcolm X.

Students will be expected to read 100-200 pages between each group meeting and engage in informal writing activities so a GED is recommended. Books and materials will be provided at no cost. The reading group will be led by Reiko Hillyer, a professor at Lewis and Clark College and an Inside-Out instructor, and Garrett Felber, a PhD student at the University of Michigan and scholar of Malcolm X.

The deadline for sending a KYTE request to Ms. LaCarney is June 15.

## **CRCI KYTE ROUTING**

**Records:** CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED, SENTENCING ISSUES, PROOF OF INCARCERATION, FACE SHEETS, RELEASE DATES, DETAINERS, EARNED TIME CREDIT ELIGIBILITY requests are generally handled through the courts but, Records/OISC at CCCF can answer your issues.

**Legal Library:** Use new Salmon colored Legal Library Kytes to ask for time to work on legal issues: conditions of confinement, post-conviction relief, Habeas Corpus, Direct Appeals, communications with the courts, or talk with a Legal Assistant, make copies, look at ORSs and OARs.

**Programs:** Birth Certificate & Social Security applications, CD28 book/gift orders.

**Counselor:** ACRS, AIP, custody issues, SFFC, incentive levels.

**IWP:** PRAS points, Employment.

**Visiting Appeals:** Inmate Services Unit Dome.

**Phone issue:** Dial 411

**Mental Health Issues:** your BHS Counselor, BHS-Mr. Menzie

**Central Trust Account:** Questions on CD 28s and your account.

**Emergency Phone Calls:** Chaplain

**Mp3/4 Player Issue & Repairs**

**Non-Functioning Devices**

**Currently, all Mp3 players are outside of the warranty period however, we have worked with our vendor and they are willing to assist in trying to repair players that are post-warranty until March 1, 2015. AICs with known issues are encouraged to act soon. New Mp4 players will carry a 60 day warranty.**

**AICs should seek a return authorization by kyting Telmate@CDC. Telmate@CDC will respond with an RA number if appropriate. Commissary is not a resource to resolve issues with players, or kiosks. Commissary's only involvement will be to provide the RA form and deliver the repaired device back to the AIC. The AIC will be responsible for sending the device out for repairs.**
