Housing Etiquette

When playing a television, radio, or tablet in your housing unit, you must use a headset or earbuds which are to be worn on your head covering your ears. Even with the use of headphones/earbuds on your head, the volume may not be heard outside of the cell. Using headphones or other devices that are capable of producing sounds such as amplifiers or keyboards as external speakers for your TV, radio, or tablet, will result in confiscation and disciplinary action.
