One year manufacturer's Warranty

The Zoom G1x Four Guitar and the Zoom B1X FOUR Bass both have a One year manufacturer's warranty. If you have issues with the device during the one year warranty period, you will need to contact your local Commissary to begin the process for warranty return. Shipping charges to and from the vendor will be your responsibility. If it is determined to be a manufacturer's defect, the unit will be repaired or replaced and shipped back to you. Please allow a minimum of 4-6 weeks from the date your device is shipped out for the unit to be returned to the institution.

Orders must be placed on the kiosk, must be at an incentive Level 3 to order.

**Please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery.**

To clarify some confusion about Certified Mail and Return Receipts, I spoke to the Post Master of the Umatilla Post Office. This was his response:

- **If an Inmate wants to send their mail Certified without a Return Receipt, they are not required to purchase a Return Receipt.**
- **A Return Receipt must be accompanied with a Certified Mail Receipt because it requires the certified tracking; they aren't able to send a Return Receipt without it.**

Requesting Tracking:

When sending a package out through R&D and tracking of the package is desired, please annotate this on the kyte provided. Please be aware that unless otherwise requested, mail is sent out via USPS. If you choose to send out through UPS, make note that UPS does not deliver to P. O. boxes.

Book Rates:

The option to send books out via "Media Mail" or "Book Rate" is authorized. It is significantly cheaper than sending it out through UPS or USPS Priority. If you wish to utilize this service, please make sure to request this on the kyte provided by R&D Staff when sending your package out. Books and only books are authorized to be sent out this way. Magazines do not meet the criteria and will be returned to us by the Post Office if an attempt is made to send them out.

# Library News

## OAR 291-139 Legal Affairs

It has now been a year and a half since the current Legal Affairs rule was incorporated. With the new rule came many changes to the Library. The legal affairs rule now defines users as Priority or General. General users are limited on what services and supplies the library supplies. The department has allowed some time for General legal users whom are indigent to continue to receive some supplies and services on cases that were active prior to the rule change. The department feels as though indigent inmates with General legal cases prior to the rule change have now had sufficient time to make accommodations for these cases. As of May 1, 2019 the library will no longer provide services and supplies outside of the scope of the legal affairs rule. Please plan accordingly for all of your GLU case needs. If you have any questions, please direct them to the TRCI Library Coordinators.

## Document Preparation

Word processing and Thumb-drives have been a success at TRCI. Priority Legal Users now have the opportunity to use word processing and utilize the saving of legal documents on an issued thumb-drive. With a few bumps with the changes we have decided to change the forms we would like inmates to use for printing documents from word processing. Note #2 in the below instructions. If you are familiar with the current process, this is key to the change.

As of May 1, 2019 the printing process will be as follows....

1. Print your legal document from the computer, by pushing Ctrl-P. This sends the document to a print queue that is managed by the library coordinator. Legal Documents must be in final format.
2. Fill out a **Law Library Photocopy request form**. Please fill these out completely so that we may determine approval of your print request. Please be aware of the proper naming of your documents noted in the word processing manual. State the document name clearly on the form. The document name is all we see in the print queue to identify the document.
3. Submit photocopy request as well as a CD28 to the library coordinator.
4. Coordinator will do a cursory review of your document, determine approval and print the document.
5. Please check your documents before leaving your callout.
