### Work Opportunity

#### Eligibility Requirements for South Fork:

1. Unfenced—In custody min. 90 days and have 1 year left PRIOR to A&D/AIP or Trans. Leave. (Preferably over 2 years)
2. No sex crimes, arson, escapes, warrants, detainers, restraining orders, or animal violations.
3. Medical and BHS clearance. Fire camp has special criteria for medical — no lower bunk restriction for 4 months prior to being here.
4. No recent major misconducts.
5. Work with current counselor to see if you are eligible. Please inform counselor if you have any special skill sets or experience (ie. HVAC, electrician, plumbing, painting, auto or diesel engine mechanic, small engine/chainsaw re-pair, sewing, etc.)

**We perform physically demanding work in adverse conditions, in rugged and steep terrain that includes some of the following tasks:**

Wildland fire fighting, tree planting, packing, and protection, chainsaw work; saw release/pre-commercial thinning, mountain beaver (boomer) trapping and euthanization, campground maintenance, bridge and trail construction/maintenance, trash pick-up, janitorial work.

**Average monthly pay (\$27.00 to \$66.00) Additional merit pay awarded for fire deployments, tree planting/packing.**

If you are minimum or getting close to minimum custody, want to work side by side with the Oregon Department of Forestry, and gain the training and ability to become a wild land firefighter in the pursuit of preserving our forests, then this may be the opportunity for you!!



## **From the Administrative Rules Program**

Below is the list of status changes made to DOC administrative rules since 5/14/19

### **PERMANENT RULES:**

#### **291-058 Structured, Intermediate Sanctions**

- Amends the rules to implement changes made in 2017 legislation related to the supervision of drug-related misdemeanors. Rule changes will now include application to drug related misdemeanors as defined in ORS 423.478 for crimes committed on or after August 15, 2017.
- Effective: 6/19/19

#### **291-077 Performance Recognition and Award System (PRAS)**

- Amends the rules to remove the 120 day waiting period.
- Effective: 6/24/19

#### **291-127 Visiting**

- Amends the rules to update language to provide clearer instructions related to the visiting process to assist adults in custody, prospective visitors, and staff.
- Effective: 7/01/19

#### **291-149 Work Release Programs**

- Amends the rules to standardize terminology and to provide clarification to the processes related to work release programs.
- Effective: 6/17/19

#### **291-158 Trust Accounts**

- Amends the rules to implement SB 844 (2017) which authorizes DOC to collect a portion of adult in custody trust account deposits for the purposes of creating transitional fund accounts, and to pay court ordered financial obligations the adult in custody may owe.
- Effective: 6/19/19

**This years LIFT Tutor training will be held in September 2019**


Do you have a High School diploma or GED, high scores in math and reading? Do you have at least 6 months clear conduct and 2+ years left on your sentence? Do you have the willingness and aptitude to help others learn? Would you like to have a work assignment that starts at 14 points? The Education Department is asking for applicants who wish to become a tutor (see Qualifications.)

**Applications are being accepted beginning 6/1/19 through 8/15/19.** Interviews with instructor panel will be in August 2019. Those with reading or math scores that are too low, but you feel you can bring them up, can still apply if you feel you can retest to the required levels. I will schedule you for the testing.

**Fill out an Inmate Work Application** completely as possible and send to Ms. Beecroft in the Education Department if you wish to be considered for the interview and training.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. No major misconduct sanctions in last 6 months
2. No program fails in last 6 months
3. No IMU housing in last 6 months
4. Have a minimum 2 years left on sentence
5. Must not be restricted to a housing unit
6. Must be willing to work on any unit or classroom
7. Legible handwriting
8. To become Tutor Certified requires a GED or High School Diploma, and CASAS reading score of 242+ and math 236+
9. Be chosen from interview with an instructor panel

## *August in History*

- **August 24, 79 A.E.** - Vesuvius, an active volcano in southern Italy, erupted and destroyed the cities of Pompeii, Stabiae and Herculaneum.
- **August 2, 1939** - Albert Einstein wrote a letter to President Franklin D. Roosevelt concerning the possibility of atomic weapons. "A single bomb of this type carried by boat and exploded in a port, might very well destroy the whole port together with some of the surrounding territory."
- **August 6, 1945** - The first Atomic Bomb was dropped over the center of Hiroshima at 8:15 a.m., by the American B-29 bomber Enola Gay. The bomb detonated about 1,800 ft. above ground, killing over 105,000 persons and destroying the city. Another estimated 100,000 persons later died as a result of radiation effects.
- **August 9, 1945** - The second Atomic bombing of Japan occurred as an American B-29 bomber headed for the city of Kokura, but because of poor visibility then chose a secondary target, Nagasaki. About noon, the bomb detonated killing an estimated 70,000 persons and destroying about half the city.
- **August 21, 1959** - President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed a proclamation admitting Hawaii to the Union as the 50th state.
- **August 6, 1965** - President Lyndon B. Johnson signed Voting Rights Act of 1965 into law. The Act suspended literacy, knowledge and character tests designed to keep African Americans from voting in the South. It also authorized the appointment of Federal voting examiners and barred discriminatory poll taxes. Congress renewed the Act in 1975, 1984 and 1991.
- **August 9, 1974** - Effective at noon, Richard M. Nixon resigned the presidency as a result of the Watergate scandal.
- **August 16, 1977** - Elvis Presley was pronounced dead at the Memphis Baptist Hospital at 3:30 p.m., at age 42.
