Mental Health Special Housing is now hiring Peer Companion positions on the Intermediate Care Housing (ICH) unit. Individuals selected for these positions will report to the ICH unit for their shift. We are looking for motivated, responsible individuals who have willingness to work with both elderly and our special needs population.

ICH Unit Peer Companions will have specific shifts and are responsible for assisting unit staff, QMHPs and treatment staff in ensuring that identified inmates housed on the ICH are getting their basic and daily needs met.

Duties may also include escort individuals to appointments, assisting individuals in groups, guiding or accompanying individuals who have difficulty walking or who are resistant to engaging in activities outside of their cells to activities in the day room or out to the ICH yard. This may include actually engaging the assigned inmate in these activities.

Access to Medical Care

Triage is held every AM during morning chow for when you are not feeling well or have a problem that requires medical attention. You are requested to have a completed medical/dental communication form for the nurse to



review. You need to sign your full name, SID number, cell number, and date. Include a brief description of your need, explaining your signs and symptoms. Please fill out the form completely to help us better meet your health care needs. The nurse will review the medical/dental communication form with you and determine if/what type of follow up care is necessary.

If a medical appointment is necessary, an appointment will be scheduled and a call pass will be issued. It is important that you keep your appointment and report promptly to the Medical Services area at the time shown on the call pass.

Should you become ill or otherwise need urgent/emergent medical attention during other times of the day, consult your supervisor or housing unit officer. Your housing until officer will call Nursing Services and triage your medical concerns awaiting further direction by Nursing staff
