Lifting of Restrictions

Loss of Privileges will be lifted for the state observed Holiday - Martin Luther King, Jr. Day starting at 8:00 am on Saturday, January 18, 2020 and ending at 10:00 pm on Monday, January 20, 2020.

- Level 1 **no lifting of holiday LOP.**
- Level 2 lifting of LOP on actual holiday only.
- Level 3 lifting of LOP for entire holiday weekend.

Privileges restricted by an AIC Management Plan issued by the Security Threat Management Unit are not lifted during Holiday periods. These restrictions remain in effect and are enforced until the date specified on the AIC Management Plan.

This does not restrict normal operations and progressive discipline, such as cell-ins or transfer to segregation for poor behavior that may be seen as a threat to others and/or the safety and security of the institution.

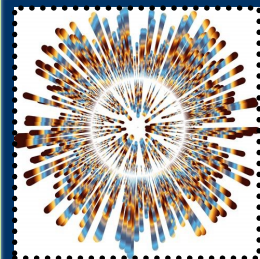
