### **PROPOSED RULES:**

#### **291-038 Pre-Sentence Reports**

- Amends the rules to update administrative rule references and reflect current business practices.
- Last day to provide comments: 01/30/20 @ 5:00 PM

#### **291-070 Records Management (Adults in Custody and Offenders)**

- Amends the rules to implement statutory language changes and to clarify rule language to align with current business practices.
- Last day to provide comments: 01/30/20 @ 5:00 PM

### **PERMANENT RULES:**

#### **291-032 Land Use Coordination**

- Amends the rules to better reflect the current practices and applicable rule and law references.
- Effective Date: 12/05/19

#### **291-210 Transgender and Intersex (AIC)**

- Amends the rules to reflect consistent standards for unclothed searches and the collection of urinalysis samples for the purpose of drug screening.
- Effective: 12/05/19
