### Lifting of Restrictions / Independence Day Holiday

Loss of Privileges will be lifted as follows for the state observed Holiday – **Independence Day/4<sup>th</sup> of July** starting at 8:00 am on Saturday, July 4, 2020 and ending at 10:00 pm on Monday, July 6, 2020.

- Level 1 **no lifting of holiday LOP**
- Level 2 lifting of LOP on actual holiday only
- Level 3 lifting of LOP for entire holiday weekend.

Privileges restricted by an Inmate Management Plan issued by the Security Threat Management Unit are not lifted during Holiday periods. These restrictions remain in effect and are enforced until the date specified on the Inmate Management Plan.

This does not restrict normal operations and progressive discipline, such as cell-ins or transfer to segregation for poor behavior that may be seen as a threat to others and/or the safety and security of the institution.

## Message from the Deputy Director / Statewide Visiting

To: All Adults in Custody

From: Heidi Steward, Deputy Director

As part of the Oregon Department of Corrections' COVID-19 continuing prevention efforts, normal visiting will remain canceled statewide until further notice. This includes non-contact visits, family visits, and attorney visits.

I know many of you hoped to open doors to visitors in the coming weeks and are disappointed to hear this news. While we are gaining ground and seeing our numbers decrease significantly, our communities are seeing increased numbers. Given this, we fear we will see another spike if we open visiting at this time.

This was no easy decision, especially knowing it's been months since kids have seen their moms and dads.

In the meantime, our Agency Operations Center is reviewing plans from each facility that include thorough screening processes and social distancing protocols in order to ensure safety for our employees, the adults in custody, and our communities.

When each facility can safely open their doors, we will make public notifications as soon as possible to help visitors plan.

## Covid-19 Q&A

1). When it comes to killing the coronavirus, what's the difference between cleaning and disinfecting?

1a). Cleaning with soap and water removes germs, dirt, and other impurities from surfaces. Disinfecting kills germs on surfaces. Both of these methods alone will decrease the spread of coronavirus. However, if you clean and then disinfect, it can lower the risk of spreading the coronavirus even further. Information was provided by the Center of Disease Control (CDC). Source (NCIRD,2020).

2). Does wearing a face mask cause carbon dioxide build up in cloth or surgical masks?

## Commissary News, Updates and Reminders

Due to the removal of the kiosks, beginning July 6, 2020, Commissaries will be providing a paper order form for NCI Level 2 & 3 items that were previously on the kiosk.

To help ensure your NCI form is processed timely, please attach it to your General Population form. The NCI orders may be delivered separately as some items are special order and can take several weeks to receive.

Please note that you must sign the Protected Funds section if you are wanting the funds deducted from that account otherwise the funds will be deducted from your general account.

Ensure you have enough funds prior to submitting the order form, you are the correct NCI level to complete your purchase and the forms are completely filled out or your order will not be processed.
