SRCI Commissary Update

Due to the current modified operations at SRCI, the SRCI Commissary will be setting spending limits to \$25.00 for all General Population and Administrative Segregation Adults in Custody. Items that do not go against your spending limits are the following:

- Envelopes
- Batteries
- Undergarments
- Any item that exceeds \$15.00

Unfortunately, at this time, the commissary will not be able to offer the following items:

- Soda coupons (**soda machines will not be filled at this time**)
- Oatmeal
- Electronic accessories
- Adaptors
- Miscellaneous and musical and;
- Ice cream

Tip: Items with a (*) symbol are items that exceed \$15.00 on the General Population Commissary form. You will find this (*) to the left of the price product.

Incentive Items:

The Commissary will be offering incentive items and these items may be ordered on the forms that will be circulated to the Housing Units. The incentive form must be attached to the GP commissary form.

Limitations will be (2) from each section except the following:

- Food items – Side Dishes (4)
- Food Items – Meats (4)
- Soups (10)
- Promo items (10)
- Envelopes and batteries no restrictions within reason

We understand that this significantly restricts ordering, however, we are currently working through this operational change with no work-crews and limited staffing. We realize the importance of commissary and are working diligently to end these restrictions as soon as it is operationally possible.

Please be advised that the spending limit will remain \$25.00 until further notice.

Engraving will be offered once the distribution windows re-open to those who bring their products and proof of purchase.

- Live in the U.S.A.
- You are NOT subject to any court order, federal or state law or regulation, other legal requirement, or any administrative rule preventing contact with the child and/or their caregiver you plan to list on the application
- You MUST have legal authority to allow the child's information to be used by Prison Fellowship Angel Tree ministry. **All applications due by August 24, 2020.**

To help ensure your form is processed timely, please attach it to your General Population form. The orders may be delivered separately as some items are special order and can take several weeks to receive.

Please note that you must sign the Protected Funds section if you are wanting the funds deducted from that account otherwise the funds will be deducted from your general account. Ensure you have enough funds prior to submitting the order form, you are the correct NCI level to complete your purchase and the forms are completely filled out or your order will not be processed.

Parenting Inside Out Class

Correctional Rehabilitation Services is looking for Adults in Custody (AIC's) that are interested in participating in the next "Parenting Inside Out" class? If so, please send a kyte to your Correctional Counselor at Box # 339 to be reviewed for placement. In order to qualify you must meet the Pathfinder Network criteria below.

- Basic Screening Criteria:
- Parents with minor children
- DHS involved parents are prioritized for placement
- Parents with offenses against minors may not be eligible for placement
- AIC's with static 99 score of 6 or higher and/or those with a PSO or PRED designator will not be placed



Classes will be 36 sessions =108 total hours, 3 days a week/3 hours a day with 16-18 participants per group.
