## CARES ACT—Economic Impact Payment (EIP)

Don't Miss the



On September 24, 2020, Judge Phyllis J. Hamilton of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California issued an order certifying a nationwide class of people incarcerated in state and federal prisons, and granting the plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction requiring the U.S. Department of Treasury, the U.S. Internal Revenue Service, and the United States of America to stop withholding CARES Act stimulus funds from plaintiffs or any class member on the sole basis of their incarcerated status.

Because of that ruling, Adults in Custody within ODOC may apply for the CARES Act Economic Impact Payment (EIP).

**The deadline for persons to apply to receive the EIP by the end of this year is, Oct. 15, 2020.** That deadline applies to persons who did not file a 2019 tax return, who have not received an EIP and those who have not already registered for an EIP.

There are two ways to register for an EIP by that deadline: (1) by filing electronically, or (2) by filing a paper form. Electronic application is not feasible and therefore DOC will make the paper form and instructions available. The AIC should make sure to have their SID# on the filing form.

Forms and instructions will be available on each housing unit. If more forms are needed, please have unit staff contact Business Services. AICs will be responsible for filling out the forms and mailing them to the following address, postmarked by Oct. 15, 2020:

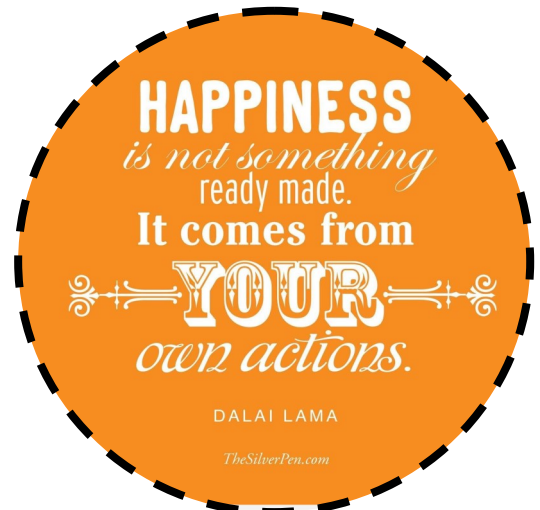

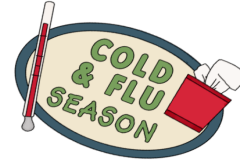

## Flu Season Approaches

The 2020-2021 flu season is fast approaching. SRCI Health Services does not have the flu vaccine yet, but in accordance with DOC policy, a vaccination priority list is being created based on the criteria below:

- AIC's with cardiovascular problems, hypertension (high blood pressure) or hyperlipidemia.
- AIC's with pulmonary problems or asthma.
- AIC's with chronic pulmonary obstructive disease.
- AIC's that are diabetic.
- AIC's older than 50.
- AIC's who are immune-compromised due to HIV and hepatitis.



Once the AIC's meet the above criteria and have been flu vaccinated, Health Services will offer the vaccine to any other AIC's wishing to be vaccinated. Simply send a communication tot Health Services and indicate "flu shot" as the subject.

## Meditation Channel 53

Starting Sunday October 11, a shortened version of SRCI's Buddhist service will be shown on Channel 53 at 7:00 AM, 8:00 AM, 9:00 AM, and 1:00 PM. The service is led by Chaplain Persinger.
