### The Month of April

The month of April gets its name from the Latin word *aperio*, meaning "to open [bud]," because plants really begin to grow

We know it is the fourth month of the year, but that's only by the Gregorian calendar that we adhere to now. It was previously the fifth month in the earlier Julian calendar.

April also only had 29 days, but a 30<sup>th</sup> day was added when Julius Caesar established the Julian calendar.

In the Southern Hemisphere, April is the seasonal equivalent of October.

No one is sure how the month ended up with its name, but we do know the Romans named it "Aprillis."

April is a great month for meteor showers. One of which is the Lyrids meteor shower, which appears from April 16<sup>th</sup> to April 26<sup>th</sup> each year. There's another one called the Eta Aquariids meteor shower that can be seen onwards from April 21<sup>st</sup>.

#### 291-202 Sex Offenders, Special Provisions



This month, we would like to share information about how your health information will be transferred to the new Electronic Health Records (EHR). An EHR is like a big computer file that stores all your health information in one place. A "scanner" is a copy machine that turns a paper document into an electronic file that is safely and securely stored. Electronic records are easily shared between your doctors, nurses, behavioral health, and dentists at the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC) and can be accessed at the same time. This will help them work together, and with you, to make important decisions about your health. Your electronic health records can also be shared with your health providers outside of the DOC, such as an out-of-facility appointment, or upon your release.

Right now, paper medical records are stored in a blue medical chart. But soon, when you visit your DOC healthcare providers, you may start seeing both a blue medical chart and a new green medical chart. The blue chart holds the old paper records that have been scanned in preparation for the EHR, and the green chart contains any new paper records created until the EHR goes live. Eventually, all the paper records will also get scanned and loaded into the EHR.



Este mes nos gustaría compartir información sobre la forma en que su información de salud será transferida a los nuevos Expedientes Electrónicos de Salud (EHR, por sus siglas en inglés). Un EHR es como un gran archivo de computadora que almacena toda su información de salud en un solo lugar. Un "escáner" es una máquina copiadora que convierte un documento en papel en un archivo electrónico que se almacena de forma segura y confiable. Los expedientes electrónicos se comparten fácilmente entre los doctores, enfermeros, especialistas de salud del comportamiento y dentistas en el Departamento Correccional de Oregon (DOC, por sus siglas en inglés) y se puede acceder a ellos al mismo tiempo. Esto les ayudará a trabajar juntos y, con usted, para tomar importantes decisiones para su salud. Sus expedientes electrónicos de salud también se pueden compartir con sus proveedores de servicios de salud fuera del DOC, como en una cita fuera del centro, o cuando se le libere.

Justo ahora, sus expedientes médicos en papel se almacenan en una carpeta médica azul. Pero pronto, cuando visite a sus proveedores de servicios de salud del DOC, podrá empezar a ver tanto la carpeta médica azul como una nueva carpeta médica verde. La carpeta azul tiene los expedientes en papel que se han escaneado en preparación para el EHR, y la carpeta verde contiene cualquier expediente en papel nuevo creado hasta que el EHR se ponga en marcha. En última instancia, todos los expedientes en papel también se escanearán y se cargarán al EHR.

Por favor, recuerde que ahora mismo no necesita hacer nada diferente para solicitar que le vean en Servicios de salud. Conforme este emocionante proyecto avanza, por favor, tenga en cuenta que le daremos más actualizaciones a través de los boletines de noticias y de los volantes de AIC.

The name origin of April is uncertain. There is a similar Latin word, aperire, that means "to open" - like Spring buds do. Aphrodite and Apollo begin the same, but they're Greek and the Romans (who used different names, like Venus) did our month naming, so a reference to "open" Spring is more likely.

April Fool's Day can be fun, or annoying, and so is its uncertain (and multiple places) origin about tricking/joking/fooling.

Arbor Day is the last Friday in April and was begun by an OG tree hugger from Nebraska, where he thought more trees were needed. Johnny Appleseed and the lady in Africa who won the 2004 Nobel Prize both planted lots of trees. Cutting down trees creates money now but planting them creates immortality later. Maybe that's why there's a famous kid's book called "The Giving Tree" - and a *Tree of Knowledge* in the beginning of the Bible - even though that tree is a metaphor for the fact that women gathered successfully while men hunted less successfully: Farming comes from copying successful gathering not from copying less successful hunting. (But Women's Month was March: "I'd rather be your wife than amount to anything" — comedian Gracie Allen to her husband, comedian George Burns.)

Earth Day is April 22 and since you live on it, you shouldn't have to be a tree hugger to try to figure out a way to respect the only planet you live on. It's weird that it takes a special day to remind us to respect nature, since we're part of it, and affected by it, all the time. Even a "day" only exists because the Earth rotates, and yet the one-day-per-year reminder to not abuse it probably isn't helping much. Earth Day began in 1970 (after we saw pictures of it from the moon). I wonder if Earth Day has helped us help the earth very much.

How fast does the earth move through space? (93 million miles radius, or distance from sun)

365 days in a year x 24 hours in a day = 8760 hours per year

Circumference = 2pieR, or 3.14 x 93m x 2 (answer is 584 million miles around the sun)

Divide C (distance in miles per year) by hours in a year to get Miles Per Hour.

We're moving in a 584 million mile circle (actually, an ellipse) through space at about **66,667 MPH**, while constantly spinning each day, too. Gravity makes me feel better.

Colorful facts: The rainbow (often seen after April showers) doesn't have **Purple**, it has **Indigo** and **Violet**, both of which are named after the plant that has that color. Purple doesn't come from a plant, and historically it's *Royal Purple*. Some colors were easier to find dyes for in nature. Purple in ancient times came only from a sea snail in the eastern Mediterranean. Once a year the snails washed upon the Phoenician shores (today's Lebanon) and those traders collected and crushed them to secrete the purple dye that was so rare in those days that <u>only royalty wore purple</u>. And the Phoenicians became rich and famous for their control of the rare and desired purple dye.

Violet is a flower and Indigo is a plant that we get a classic blue colored dye from. That's why Blue Jeans are blue (denim/cotton starts white). Blue was a very common color for clothes once the human tragedy of slave Plantations got established. By the time Levi Strauss started taking canvas sails off abandoned boats in San Francisco Bay to cut and stitch into rugged gold-miner pants, he could still get a bunch of indigo cheaply, and "blue jeans" were born. Today, jeans of any color are possible, but indigo blue is the

original, even though working on an indigo plantation usually gave people THE BLUES.





COVID-19 Booster Vaccines will be offered to those patients that are 65 years of age and older, as well as to patients who may be immunocompromised. These patients should receive two doses of Spikevax (Moderna) 23-24 vaccine to be up to date in vaccines. If you are under 65 years of age, are not immunocompromised, and have already received your COVID-19 Spikevax (Moderna) 23-24 vaccine — you are up to date on your vaccines and do not need another. If you have not received your COVID-19 Spikevax (Moderna) 23-24 vaccine, and you want it, please send a kyte to medical to receive it.
